The **Woodhill 100** Offroad Race held in the Woodhill Forest is not only the oldest running offroad racing event in NZ but is also the longest continually running endurance motorsport event in NZ making it one of the most iconic motorsports events in NZ. The **Woodhill 100** is run by the Auckland Offroad Racing Club (AORC) and this year will be the 36th running of the event.

This year the event is to be held on Queens Birthday weekend with scrutineering and the qualifying sprints (to determine grid position) to be held on Saturday 4th June and the race to be held on Sunday 5th June.

Programme:

Saturday 4th June

9.00am to 4.00pm (Gates Open at 8.30am) - Scrutineering & Sprint Qualifying – Coast Road Muriwai. Turn off SH16 at Waimauku onto Muriwai Road. Will be signposted.

11.00am to 11.45 Kiwitricks Scrutineering and Drivers Briefing

Subject to availability we may run a qualifying for the Kiwitricks before their enduro.

12noon to 1.00pm Kiwitruck Race. This consists of a 30 minute enduro. Immediately after the completion of their enduro we will hold a prizegiving ceremony.

1.00pm to 4.00pm Sprints and Registration will start again

Entry Fee & Close Off:

We have had to raise the Entry Fee to \$450 (from \$400 last year) for the event directly as a result of the increased level of restitution required, and the increase of the transponder levy.

But if you pay your Entry Fee prior to Friday 27th May and if for some reason you cannot compete at the Qualifying Sprint then we will provide full refund. Entries will be accepted after Friday 27th May and up to the day of the Qualifying Sprint but you will not feature in the programme. However it would be nice if entries could be submitted ASAP to help our administration volunteers.

Main Race Location:

Woodhill Forest, Coast Road, Muriwai Township End.

Follow the signs from Kumeu heading North on State Highway 16.

Turn left at Muriwai Road, then after 8kms, right onto Motutara, then right again onto Coast Road by the Fire Station. Straight ahead to gate entry.

Follow road side signage.

Or if coming from the North, turn right into Muriwai Road!!

Scrutineering & Qualifying Sprints:

Saturday 4th June from 9.00am to 4.00pm

Woodhill Forest, Coast Road, Muriwai Township End.

Scrutineering & Registration:

Please park as directed

Register at AORC registration, taking your safety gear and your passenger safety gear for inspection. You and your passenger will be issued with wrist bands for the weekend. Transponders will be issued too.

ALL RACE VEHICLES MUST BE TAGGED

This gear includes **race overalls, race helmet, neck brace, race boots, goggles/visor and race gloves.**

Once you have registered and then had your safety gear inspected, proceed to scrutineering, and once scrutineered, proceed to qualifying sprint, lining up in single file.

All passengers must be signed in at registration.

Qualifying Sprints:

Once you have completed scrutineering, please proceed to the queue for the qualifying sprint. You will undergo a belt, neck brace and helmet check, and be briefed on the qualifying lap.

Sunday Scrutineering & Qualifying:

If you are unable to make the Saturday scrutineering, you can be scrutineered on the Sunday morning at the track, **but you start off the back of the grid as per ORANZ Rulebook in class order as following:- 1, 8, 3, 10, U, 4, C, 5, 6, 2 and 7.**

Rules:

These are to ORANZ rulebook. To be classed as a finisher you must complete 60% of the distance completed by the overall leading vehicle. It is important that you have the required minimum fire extinguisher requirements (**2kg** in the vehicle), a neck brace, fire rated gloves and the correct sponsors decals. **Spark arrestors** are mandatory and will be checked at scrutineering.

No dogs allowed.

No smoking in the forest

No alcohol allowed to be consumed in the pits during racing.

Race Fuel:

No race gas (Avgas) will be available at the event.

Fuelling Bay:

There is a designated fuel bay inside the entry to the pits monitored by the Fire Brigade. Driver and passenger must be outside the vehicle completely during refuelling; fuel cap is not to be touched till all feet of the occupants have touched the ground – **no exceptions**. Pit Marshall will check belts, neck brace, gloves and helmet before re-entering race track, you must wait and only re-enter the race track on the Pit Marshalls command.

Gate Entry:

Competitors and crew towing a race car will be given free entry.

Spectators (anyone not towing a race vehicle) will be charged \$10 per adult; persons under 15 will be free.

Food:

There will be a food caterer and coffee supplier on site supplying hot food and hot drinks. Bring cash as Mobile Eftpos may not work.

Race Car Pit Parking

On arrival please obey the signs and the parking marshal. Only vehicles towing race cars will be allowed into the pit area. First in best parked.

Spectator Car Parking

Saturday: Spectators \$5 per person, under 15 free

Sunday: Spectators \$10 per person, under 15 free

On arrival please obey the signs and the parking marshal. First in best parked. Please note will be designated disabled parking area at head of spectator parking.

Kiwitruck Racing:

The Kiwitrucks will start racing at 12 midday on Saturday only on a specialised track. The race will be a 30 minute enduro.

Drivers Briefing:

This will be held at Race Control at 10.00am. The event manager will start the briefing with a roll call and then hand over to the Clerk of the Course (Glenn Goosen). All drivers and passengers must attend.

Grid Line Up:

This is to start at 10.30am. The order will be posted at Race Control from 8.00am. Please ensure you know who you are behind and beside on the grid to make it easier for the grid crew. You will be directed to the grid set out and will approach the area from the rear of the field / grid, simply drive down the centre of the road and pull into your grid position either to the left or right as you drive down the centre of the road. The grid crew will do final belt, neck brace and helmet check 10 minutes prior to start. Pole position will be on the inside line to the first corner.

Race Start:

The green flag will drop at 11.00am. It is your responsibility to be on the grid and ready.

Race Length:

Please note AORC are still in discussions with the forestry managers regarding an approved track but it is our intention to create a track approximately 200kms in length. AORC reserve the right to increase or decrease the length of the event based on forestry management requirements.

Tail End Charlie:

Will be sent out 30 minutes after the chequered flag drops. You can complete your lap provided Tail End Charlie does not pass you. The race track is still live until the tail end Charlie completes their lap.

Retrieval of Cars:

This will be controlled from Race Control/Registration. No unauthorised vehicles are permitted onto the race track to recover broken down cars. If unauthorised vehicles are seen in the forest you will be dealt with accordingly. Marshals will recover any vehicles provided the driver is present.

Forest Check Out:

Once your race vehicle and crew are back in the pits please head to Race Control/Registration to check out and collect your log book, and return your transponder. This is for safety to ensure nobody is left in the forest.

Prizegiving / Dinner:

This year the dinner and prizegiving will occur immediately upon completion of the event. We want to capture everybody as they leave the event and hence the venue –Muriwai Surf Club, Jack Butt Lane, Muriwai.

The dinner will be burgers. This is a fundraiser for the Muriwai Surf Life Saving team that are competing overseas later on this year. The Bar will be open as well. Please give an indication of how many may be eating on your entry form.

Prizegiving will be conducted by AORC President (Glen Houghton) and AORC Vice President (Brendon Holland) with trophy presentation by the sponsors.
